

SOHS Blues Criteria

A Blue is a reward for **EXCELLENCE** and **ACHIEVEMENT** in a school sport or cultural activity. Out of school activities may be considered in exceptional circumstances. A Blue is NOT a service award.

Nominations can come from anyone, at any time, as long as they are submitted by **Friday 20th September 2024** and also **endorsed by a coach, manager or instructor** of the activity. No late nominations will be accepted.

Once a blue has been received in a particular field, it is unlikely that one for the same activity will be repeatedly awarded in following years. EG. you will not be able to get two or more blues in one field, even if you make a rep team the following year.

Criteria

1. Be a senior student - in very exceptional circumstances, juniors and teams may be awarded a Blue
EG: NZ representative, NZ qualifier, NZ award winner
2. Represent SOHS - in very exceptional circumstances, playing for a club or competing/performing unattached to the school, may be considered
3. Show a consistent commitment to an activity and display behaviour that will bring credit to the school.
4. Perform at a high level.

All nominations are to be forwarded to the school office. The final awarding of a Blue shall be decided by the SOHS Blues Awards committee.

Guidelines

Athletics	First place at Otago Southland SS champs or place at South Island SS
Badminton	Otago age groups and performance at a high level
Tennis	Otago age groups and performance at a high level
Basketball	Otago age groups and performance at a high level
Touch	Otago team girls/boys/mixed and performance U18
Netball	Dunedin under 19 (Otago Team), or similar, NZ developmental squad
Hockey	Otago team (not a development team) and performance at a high level
Football	Otago age group team and performance at a high level
Rugby	Highlanders Develop. team or Otago SS team. Performance at a high level in Otago Country
Cross Country	Placing at Otago/Southland, place at Nationals
Equestrian	Otago or Southland Event team, individual placings in Show Jumping (Otago)
Swimming	Placing at SISS or National SS qualifier
Cricket	Selection for Otago SS team or Higher
Speech	First place at Regional Competition
Kapa Haka	Kaitataki Kotiro or Kaitataki Tane in a placing performance at Te Hautonga Otago/Southland
Manu Korero	Placing at a Otago Competition
Rockquest	Placing at Regional Finals, or a winning individual award ie Best Vocalist, or Best Guitar
Performance Music	Grade 5 (with merit or above)
Dance	Grade 5 (Highly Commended or above) RAD or BBO
Visual Art	Placing in a Regional Competition
Drama	Winner in a Regional Competition ie. Sheila Winn Shakespeare
Theatre Sports	Winner in a Regional Competition
Refereeing/umpiring	Selected to referee a representative high level match (EG. A-grade netball game at OSS)
Other	National representation
